Nominations for Board Appointments to Nunavut's Institutions of Public Government

The Government of Canada is seeking individuals interested in serving as federal appointees on the following Institutions of Public Government:

Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal:	resolves disputes over access to lands and compensation
Nunavut Water Board:	regulates and manages fresh water in the Nunavut Settlement Area
Nunavut Impact Review Board:	screens project proposals for environmental, social and economic impacts

Board members will receive travel allowances and a daily honorarium when the board meets.

Preference will be given to candidates who are beneficiaries of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement and/or residents of Nunavut with experience and abilities in some of the following areas:

- mediation/dispute resolution
- environmental assessment
- mining background
- surface rights law
- site restoration
- land use planning
- resources law
- water and land resource management
- indigenous knowledge

As a condition of appointment, candidates must be willing to undergo and successfully pass a security clearance.
